Number recruited and allocated/randomized: Schools were the experimental units. We had 34 schools (17 intervention, 17 control) in the program with an expected 20 families per preschool for a total of 680 potential participants.

Number allocated/randomized to each intervention/arm (please edit as relevant):

Arm 1: 17 schools (intervention), female carers of 433 children

Arm 2: 17 schools (control), female carers of 486 children

(Male carers were not included in follow up in both groups due to low recruitment at baseline)

Arm 1: 17 schools (intervention), 291 female carer's completed pre-intervention/baseline survey; 233 female carers completed post-intervention survey.

Arm 2: 17 schools (control), 326 female carers completed pre-intervention/baseline survey; 250 female carers completed post-intervention survey
